Introduction

On June 13, 2017 a team of three (3) comprising Mr. G. Alvin Roberts, Extension Officer, Mrs. Victoria Karlon, Inventory Officer and Mr. Emmanuel B. Wilson, Driver, departed Monrovia for Rivergee and Grand Gedeh Counties to facilitate the posting of results of Validation and Social Economic & Reconnaissance Survey Result to Establish an Authorized Forest Community in Putu and Chedepo applicant community forests.

The team makes a stop in Pennokon Town, Putu Administrative District where a meeting was held to post the results. The team continues to Jarkaken Town, the seat of Chedepo Administrative District, Rivergee County.

In the two applicant communities, participants from various towns/villages of the applicant communities gathered at town halls where subsequent introduction and objective of the visits were done by the team leader; that the exercise was in two phases but will be done at once, phase one (1) has to do with the posting of the SER Survey result while phase two (2) was Posting of the Validation result as well. These results will be posted for thirty days which is step six (6) of the nine steps of the CRL.

Objective

The objective of the exercises are in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 10, of the Community Rights Law (CRL) and its Regulations,

which provides that both SER & Validation result most be posted for thirty days in the given Communities and adjacent Communities prior to the dispute resolution.

Methodology

The methods used by the team during the exercises were the Community Entry methods and the Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) tools.

These include;

- Met with Local authorities and informed them about the Mission.
- Delivered letters from the Managing Director of FDA to the Local Authority
- Held town hall meetings (for Posting SER & Validation results for the establishment of an authorized community forest status)
- Entertained Questions and Answers for clarity
- Posting SER & Validation results to be reviewed for 30 days

Proceedings

On June 15, 2017. The team arrived in Jarkaken Town, Chedepo Administrative District for the posting of their results.

The community people representing the 9 towns assembled at the town hall for the meeting. Prominent persons from the Chedepo applicant community that were present in the meeting included the

District Commissioner Hon. Bolton Dwehswen, the Community Forest representative, Mr. Josiah Welleh and Mr. Sylvester Kenta, Youth President.

During the meeting, we reviewed with them the nine steps to remind them of the efforts they have made to reach to the current step and what they need to do to advance to the remaining ones. We display the two results and drilled them through by explaining to them that every information on the SER survey result was what they provided during the SER survey period. Mrs. Victoria Karlon, Inventory Officer from the GIS department took up the Chedepo forest map and explained it to them. They agreed to everything on the map yet except that Gbaquiah Town and Torroken Town was on the map but not in the list of towns in the SER Survey result. The District Commissioner, Hon. Dwehswen promised to meet with the people reach the people of Gbaquiah to address the issue while Torroken is surely part of their forest and should be included on the list.

We distributed sets of copies to each representative of the affected towns and villages launched the posting of the results for thirty (30) days in designated forest Communities in the presence of the local authorities and the concerned community members. The community members were instructed to continue the posting of the result at key points in adjacent communities where those who were not present during the exercise, will be able to see the two results.

At the end of the exercises, the community members and the local authority thanked the FDA team for the education on the various steps of the CRL which gave rise to the Social Economic Survey and validation results, one of the procedure leading to communities' forest status. According to local leaders, they hope to see FDA for the next step as soon as possible.

We departed for Monrovia upon completion of the work the following day.

Observations

- Community representatives from attended the meeting low numbers.
- Community representatives complained about transportation and feeding.
- The long gap in time from previous step reduces the community people's interest to some extent.

Constraints

Bad road condition in this rainy season.

Recommendations

 Adequate mobilization of community members for a day or two before SER & validation results are taken to them for posting.


