
Field Report from Community Forest Elections for

Chedepo Applicant Community, Rivergee

Date:

March 26, 2021

This report under review covers activities marking the setting up of the Community Assembly and its Executive Committee in **Chedepo** applicant community forest in fulfillment of step eight(8) of the CRL and its Regulations. The Election was held on March 23, 2021 in Jarkaken Town. Herein is an attachment of the report to be perused.



### Background/Introduction

According to the Community Rights Law Regulation of 2017 (Chapter 3 Section 1, 3, 4 and 7), powers to lead and govern an Authorized Forest Community shall be through the establishment of a Community Assembly (CA). The Community Assembly shall be the highest decision- making body of the community with respect to community forestry. The Community Assembly members shall be elected by their various constituencies through a secret ballot. The Authority which is the Forestry Development Authority (FDA) shall supervise the election of representatives to the Assembly and its leaders. Representatives of at least two civil society organizations shall be invited to witness the elections and validate that they have been undertaken in a free, fair and transparent manner.

After successfully completing step 7, the Chedepo Applicant Community informed the Authority of their readiness for step 8(Governance). Due to budgetary and other constraints, the FDA provided them the necessary awareness about the elections process and gave them the go-ahead to conduct elections at the town level and elect at least two delegates from each of the 26 towns for representation at the Community Assembly. They completed this process in March 23-24, 2021 and officially informed the Authority.


To this effect, the FDA sent a Team comprising the Manager, Extension Services & Mobilization and Civil Society representative, Tenneh K. Subah (WA) to the Chedepo Applicant Community Forest on March 26-27, 2021 to conduct elections for the Community Assembly and the Executive Committee of the Assembly, and to create adequate awareness for setting up of the Community Forestry Management Body (CFMB). The elections were held on March 27, 2021 at the Jarkaken Town, Chedepo District.

### **Pre-Election Activities**

The FDA team arrived in **Jarkaken Town** on the evening of March 25, 2021 and informed the local authority including the Commissioner of Chedepo District, **Hon. J. Bolton Dwehswen** and the acting CF Chairperson, Madam. Nickey Jah. The team was informed that the folks from the far away town and villages had not come in full. They begged one day since participants were coming from distant and tough terrain taken into consideration the rainy season.

### **Elections Conduct and Procedure**

The Elections commenced at exactly 10:00 a.m. after all representatives from the affected communities, members of the local authority, and observers were seated. FDA team head served as facilitator for the elections. The meeting with a word of prayer. After the prayer, the Township Commissioner Tulton S. Jah welcome every participants but especially FDA to the meeting through a traditional process the Commissioner urged his community people to pay keen attention and participate fully in the activities. Each Community was represented by two persons who automatically qualified to represent them on the Community Assembly with the acceptation of Jarkaken who had three representatives on ground that it is their district headquarters. Madam. Gray conducted a roll call to verify the presence of the delegates. Each community correctly answered yes to their name. He read to them affirmation statements that they responded to with a "yes". The statements ascertained the full implementation of election guidelines as enshrined in the CRL Regulations in the election of the delegates from their respective towns. They were 23 delegates in all, two representing each of the 11 affected towns. They were immediately sworn into office by Madam. Gray on behalf of the FDA and witnessed by Mrs. Subah on behalf of the Civil Society.



Community Assembly members representing the 11 affected towns


The new Community Assembly convened immediately to elect their leadership – the Executive Committee. This election was supervised jointly by FDA and CSO who carefully explained to them the roles and responsibilities of the posts they were vying for. Nomination was opened and the CA members nominated candidates for the four (4) positions provided for in the CRL Regulations:

Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary, and Finance Officer. After a very transparent process, those elected were:

Josiah Welleh Chairman
 Wilson M. Swen Vice Chairman
 Botoe Toeson Secretary
 Randolph Gbegah Finance Officer

5. Matty Slober Chaplain

Note all of the candidates won by mean of white ballots with the acceptation of the chaplain who was appointed to serve.

Under the Chairmanship of Mr. Welleh, the Community Assembly convened its first session to develop the criteria for selection and appointment of the Community Forestry Management Body (CFMB). The Assembly deliberated for an hour and agreed to the following **criteria**:

That any member of the CFMB should be:

- A citizen of Chedepo
- · Should be able to read and write
- Married with family

- 18 year old and above
- Of good and responsible character

Following the elections, Miss. Gray, on behalf of the FDA confirmed officers of the EC. With that done, Mrs. Tenneh K. Subah cautioned the inductees and the Community Assembly members to do away with corruption and mal-practices, undermining, and falsehood. She admonished them of the importance of the role as Civil Society Observer and encouraged them to remain submissive to the mandate of the Community Right Law and its Regulations.

In his acceptance speech, Mr. Josiah Welleh, Chairman of the Executive Committee thanked the Clan Chief Hon. Denial C. Keh for his role in the process despite all of the challenges and problems. He did not hold back words of praises for the level of maturity exhibited by his colleagues during the exercises. He also thanked FDA and CSO for their transparent supervision and promised to work with his colleagues at the CA to bring development that will be satisfactory for all citizens of the affected communities.

### **REMARKS/COMMENTS**

**Civil Society Organization Mrs.** Tenneh K. Zubah of the Women Alert Initiative, reemphasized the call for the CA and its EC to stick to the demands of the CRL and it Regulations. She further told them to do everything they can to ensure good governance of their forest and if their need for assistance of her organization, at any point in time they can be reach.

**Paramount Chief –** Hon. Denial C. Keh also praised the maturity of the community people during the exercises. He congratulated the FDA and Civil Society for overseeing a transparent process. He promised to work with the folks of Chedepo to ensure that the CFMB is set up in the shortest possible time.

**Township Commissioner** – Hon. Robert B. Quayee, thanked the FDA for the smooth conduct of the elections. He promised the Authority their corporation with the community forest leadership as local county officials.



This report under review covers activities marking the setting up of the Community Forestry Management Body (CFMB) of Chedepo applicant community forest in fulfillment of step eight(8) of the CRL and its Regulations. The Election was held on March 30, 2021 in Jarkaken Town, Chedepo Statutory District, Rivergee County. Herein is an attachment of the report to be perused.



### Background/Introduction

According to the Community Rights Law Regulation of 2017 (Chapter 3 and 4 Section), powers to lead and govern an Authorized Forest Community shall be through the establishment of a Community Assembly (CA) which shall be the highest decision- making body of the community with respect to community forestry and shall be elected by their various constituencies through a secret ballot. This CA shall elect its Executive Committee which shall in turn recruit, select and appoint the five-member Community Forestry Management Body based on pre-determined criteria. The selection and appointment of the CFMB members shall be fair and transparent and be supervised by the Authority in the presence of Civil Society representatives.


After the successful setting up of the Community Assembly and its Executive Committee, the CA of Chedepo Applicant Community Forest was left to recruit and select five-members of the CFMB. After soliciting applications, screening and selecting the five members, the CA through its EC informed the FDA that it was ready to present the results of the recruitment to the Assembly and FDA and to proceed therefrom with election of the Chief Officer, Secretary and Treasurer of the CFMB.

To this effect, the FDA sent a Team head by Manager, **Weedor H. Gray** and Civil Society representative, **Tenneh K. Subah** (WA) to the Chedepo Applicant Community Forest on March 28, 2021 to witness elections of the officials of the five-member Community Forestry Management Body. The elections were held at the meeting hall Jarkaken Town in Chedepo Statutory District. The team stopped at the Region office in Zwedru City after a tough ride for debriefing.

The team arrived at night in Rivergee and spent the night in Jarkaken Town in Chedepo. We were received by the Township Commissioner, Hon. Robert B. Quayee and the Clan Chief, Hon Denial C. keh of Jarkaken Town. The entire team and community representatives as well as members of the Community Assembly proceeded to the Meeting Hall for the program on the 30th of March 2021.

### **Elections Conduct and Procedure**

The Elections commenced at exactly 9:30 a.m. after several delays in efforts to get the full CA membership. With majority members of the CA and EC as well as members of the local authority present, an agenda was developed and the program commenced with prayer offered by Mrs. Matty Slober. The Chairman of the committee, Mr. Josiah Welleh, welcomed everyone to the occasion and asked the citizens to give their undivided attention and conduct themselves properly for the Election.




A Cross section of Community Assembly members at the setting up of the CFMB in Chedepo

Chairman Welleh took the floor to conduct a roll call of Assembly members. From the roll call it was observed that representatives from (11) towns were present during the meeting. He then presented to the Authority the five members that were selected from the screening they conducted. The five members included four men and one woman. The five members were asked by the Assembly to state which posts on the CFMB they were interested in and they stated specific positions they wanted. The Chairman Financial Officer and Secretary Won on white ballots and the other two are member automatically.

The Hon. Clan Chief, Hon. Keh, confirmed members and officers of the CFMB into office as citizen applause the assembly members and other observers. He further said we choose or elected you people to manage our forest. As of now, you have the power to stop all illegal activities, thank and congratulations.

### **Closing Session**

The Chief Officer, Madam Nickey D. Jah thanked all members of the community assembly for accepting her to the position. She promised to work in the interest of the people and cautioned the rest of the community people to give her their support. She pledge to do the work of her people and that the citizen of Chedepo will be her first priority for the job given her. She further thanked the FDA and the local authority for their patience and efforts ensuring the success of the election and will continuous working along with the FDA for success.

**Tenneh K. Subah of WA – Women Alert**, thanked the community and their various governing bodies for their patience and commitment to the process. She further thank FDA for a free, fair and transparent elections and that God should blessed us all.

Chan Chief, Hon. Denial C. Keh, began with these words "Integrity matters, work with us and we will work with you". He congratulated the new members and officers of the CFMB. He thank the FDA and Civil Society and rest of the citizen for their tireless efforts exerted in ensuring a successful elections.
